Expectations of the Winners

These are a listing of the event producers' expectations of our titleholders after winning their respective title.

- Our goal for our title-holders first & foremost is to be an effective representation of the title locally and regionally. While we want your focus to be in Atlanta and the Southeast, if our titleholder decides to proceed further to either IML, IMsL, ABW, or MIR respectively then we will help them prepare for their contest.
  - We expect that we can assist you in this effort by:
    - Make introductions to other titleholders, producers
    - Provide coaching for competing in other contests
    - Suggesting fundraiser ideas
    - Providing guidance on conducting yourself as title holder
- Preferences and expectations regarding proceeding to higher level of competition.
  - While it is not required to proceed to a higher level contest after your ALP win, we do support our titleholders as indicated above when they choose to do so. Because the higher level contests (IML, IMsL, ABW, MIR) are scattered throughout the year we have provided our preferences and expectations in terms of when to run for these titles in relation to your ALP title win.
    - MIR – Expectation is that you will run in MIR the same year as your ALP win.
    - IMsL – Because IMsL is typically within two weeks of ALP the expectation is to wait one year.
    - IML – IML is typically 6 weeks after ALP. We prefer the winner to go the same year, but understand a wait may be necessary for preparation.
    - ABW – Expectation is that you will run for ABW the same year as your ALP win.
- Our goal is to have our title holders present at as many of the monthly barnights as possible. If attendance is not possible then please contact producers as soon as you know.
  - Hotlanta Rubber and Gear Club barnight is currently scheduled for the first Saturday of each month. Titleholder is expected to help promote the event leading up to it. During the barnight assist in bartending and/or selling shooters as well as assisting with fundraisers. Tips/donations from these barnights go to support Hotlanta Rubber and Gear club events in the future unless previously discussed and agreed to by the Producers.
  - Mr. & Ms. Atlanta Eagle barnight is currently scheduled for the third Friday of each month. Titleholders are expected to bartend (can solicit assistance if needed) and make/sell jell-O shooters as needed as well as any additional fundraisers. Tips/donations from these barnights can be used at the discretion of the titleholders after consulting producers with intentions.
- During your title year, you will be expected to coordinate and host the following:
  - Fundraiser to benefit your travel fund.
  - Fundraiser to benefit the travel fund of the following year's winner.
  - Fundraiser to benefit a charity of your choosing.
- Serve the community as a triad; plan and execute as a family when and where possible. Support and encourage each other by:
  - cross-promoting each other's events

- attending each other's events
  - being a proactive advocate and supporter of other members of your sash family.
- We expect you to exercise social intelligence in recognition of the visibility a title-holder has. And we expect you to respect the title you have; you are a figurehead, a representative. You will be seen as an extension of the bar, a lifestyle, and even a group of your peers so we expect that you will remain true to who you are and what you believe in.
- We do understand that everyone has opinions about topics and we respect that individuality. These opinions may not always be in agreement with that of the producers, your peers, your club brothers & sisters, the bar or its owner. We request that when these differences arise you keep decorum in mind with regards to your title. If there are questions pertaining to what may be appropriate please contact your producers in advance and we will assist. Please keep in mind you are representing the title, club, bar, and your community. These titles are to be protected, honored, and most importantly passed to your successor.
